



## Clean Up Official

**Rational:** MHCBA needs to have someone from each team responsible for the cleanliness of the gyms the MHCBA uses for games. Having one person responsible at each game will allow MHCBA to “police” the cleanliness of the gyms. This will also help us have a positive personal relation with the schools, custodians, and the schools boards that we take the gyms use serious. Please ensure that the practice gyms are given the same respect as a game gym.

**Procedure:** Both Teams team will provide a “Clean-up” official. This person will sign the score-sheet confirming that they oversee keeping the facility clean. This person will have to come to the gym 15 minutes early to make sure that they are there before the other game finishes.

### **Duties:**

Make sure that absolutely NO ONE is wearing their outdoor shoes in the gym.

Make sure parents from their own team are not bringing in coffee, other beverages (except water), and/or snacks into the gymnasiums.

Make sure any trash that is left behind (coffee cups, water bottles) are collected and put in the garbage cans.

Make sure that the team benches are clear of water bottles, tape and any other items that are left behind.

The clean-up official can be the same as the score keeper, time keeper, team manager or one of the coaches but it must be an adult.

**Sanctions:** If your team has been found in non-compliance of this, we will follow the normal discipline procedure. Sanctions will include a warning for the first offense and may lead to possible forfeit of a game as well as ineligibility for the playoffs. Please understand that we will that we will be very strict with the cleanup official as leaving a dirty gym is one of the top reasons as to why we lose gyms.
